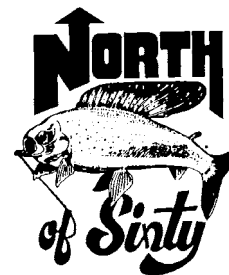

The Only Way To Preserve A Trophy Fishery...

Limited fishing pressure...Catch and Release & Barbless hooks, is not enough. Short season Mid June to Mid July. Limit the number of guests at each camp per trip per year. Alternate camps with less than 1/2 of our camps open each year. Plus we limit 2 camps to max of 1 or 2 trips per year total. Fish cradles, We discourage taking fish out of the water. Trophy fish cannot support their body weight out of the water.



Safe efficient transportation...50 passenger Convair non-stop flight from Winnipeg, to our 6000 foot all weather IFR airstrip next to our lodge. Scheduled arrival at our lodge is 9:30 AM and your return arrive Winnipeg at 2:30 PM to connect with your flight home. North of Sixty Flying Services, Inc has its float planes based at our Lodge. We can coordinate your trip from anywhere in the world.

Location...We cover over 10,000 square miles, with ten camps. Fish waters that may never have been fished. Located in the center of the Dubawnt, Thelon and Kazan river system. 250 miles from Lynn Lake and 125 miles from Stony Rapids with a hospital. No other settlements. Too remote for commercial fishing.

Reasonable costs... North of Sixty does not use a middle man, no brokers. REPEAT CLIENTS. This combined with Efficient safe transportation with 50 passenger charter from Winnipeg and float planes based at Obre Lake allows us to pass these savings on to you.

Options Not Included but Available:

- Guide for 5 day - \$275 each, 6 day - \$325 each. Minimum 2 guests. (If additional boat shares a guide: \$50(5day), \$60(6day), \$90(9day)
- Overtime - \$20/hour. Normal guide hours 8 AM to 6 PM but can be changed.
- Depth finder - not necessary with guide. \$25/boat (5 day), \$30(6 day), \$45(9 day)
- Deductible insurance - not necessary with guide. \$80/boat (5 day), \$100/boat (6 day) \$160/boat (9 day)
- Boat or lower unit damage \$1,000 each (\$250 w/insurance)
- Skag damage - \$300 (\$100w/insurance),
- Rock Hopper or Prop - \$150 (\$50 w/insurance), Depth gauge - \$150 (\$50 w/insurance).
- Extra boat and motor - \$100 per day plus gas
- Walk-in lakes out of Obre - No Charge
- Fly-out lakes - subject to availability - \$300 per person.(minimum 4 guests)
- Loaner tackle - no charge - pay for what you loose or break

Liquor and Beverages - North of Sixty is a dry camp for employees. No beer or liquor may be given to any camp employee. This is a violation of the law and you will be liable for civil, criminal, and/or consequential damages. Guest giving beer or liquor to guides will lose their guide and not have a guide the following day. No credit issued.

In the event that circumstances beyond our control (ie ice) prevents guests from accessing their camp, North of Sixty Camps has the option to change camps. If trip is cancelled, due to conditions beyond our control, guests will be rescheduled at a later date when space permits. No refunds off price of trip and/or credit for changes in travel arrangements.

Weight Limitations Will Be Enforced: Each guest may bring a maximum of 45lbs of belongings, including clothing, tackle box, rods, reels, etc. and a 5 lb carry-on. Excess weight will not be allowed. All carry-on luggage must fit beneath the seat. No overhead storage other than jackets. Luggage is weighed prior to boarding the plane in Winnipeg, prior to boarding the floatplane and prior to returning to Winnipeg. Suggestions for keeping within weight limit: Combine rod cases and tackle boxes with fishing partner's, wear boots and warm jacket on plane.

Deposits Payment Schedule: Deposits - all monies paid are non-refundable. Deposit schedule - \$300 down \$300 due December 1, 2008 (total \$600), \$900 due February 1, 2009. Deposits are payable via cash, check, Visa, Master Card or Discovery. Balance is due 60 days prior to departure. If you wish to use your credit card for the entire trip, you must pay the total balance due within sixty (60) days of departure or May1, whichever comes first. If payments are not made when due, deposits will be lost. "At Camp Charges" require a credit card on file or \$100 cash deposit/person. **We recommend trip insurance - no refunds.**

AMERICAN PLAN at MINI LODGES - North of Sixty's concept of what an outpost should be:

The tranquility of an outpost but with many of the modern conveniences of a lodge. A camp manager coordinates fishing and prepares breakfast and dinner. Meals are served in central mini lodge, with 3 separate sleeping cabins for guests - mattresses/pillows and satellite phones to talk with the main lodge. 16.5' boats are equipped with a 15HP motor, life preservers, seats with backs, fish cradle, rock hopper, paddles and a map of the lake. Guests bring sleeping bags and towels. All prices are based on a minimum of 2/4 guests per cabin and 2 guests per boat. Extra charge for one person per cabin and/or boat. **24 gallons of fuel (average used less than 20 gallons) \$180**

Obre Lake Lodge

Our intention at our lodge on Obre Lake is to provide you with a comfortable and relaxing atmosphere with the opportunity to catch trophy fish. Limiting the number of guests each season enables us to control the fishing pressure and creates a quiet, relaxed and comfortable camp.

The Lodge

salads, home made bread and deserts. This is your trip and we want to accommodate you. The cabins at Obre Lake Lodge have a full bathroom with showers. Generators for electricity and we use propane furnaces for heat. Each cabin has a refrigerator to keep your beverages cold and the lodge has a full service bar. Guides are optional and may be shared. If you fish elsewhere without a guide you will not require one at Obre. Maps and GPS coordinates are available. Each motor is equipped with a rock hopper to help protect the prop and lower unit. This will not stop all damage but it greatly reduces the damage. The boats at Obre are 16.5 ft and 18 ft with spring loaded swivel seats, life jackets, paddles, fish cradles, platforms and 20 or 25 HP Mercury motors. The lodge has a tackle shop with loaner equipment. Pay for what you loose or break. Obre Lodge also can provide day fly outs to near by lakes and/or overnight to mini lodges.

Location -Location - Location The Key to Trophy Fishing

These camps are at the heart and soul of the North of Sixty trophy fishing. **Our concept in trophy sport fishing camps is a fully managed facility, offering you the tranquility of an outpost, but with the modern conveniences of a lodge.**



A camp manager coordinates fishing and prepares both breakfast and dinner. Each camp has separate sleeping cabins for guests and a mini-lodge where meals will be served or guests can relax and play cards. In other respects all camps are similar with flush toilets, hot showers, propane furnaces, lights, mattresses/pillows, satellite phones or short-waves to talk with the main lodge and a small generator for charging batteries. The 16.5 ft boats at each mini-lodge are fully equipped with 15 HP motors, rock hoppers, padded swivel seats, life jackets, paddles, fish cradles and a map of the lake.



Guests will need to bring fishing gear and a sleeping bag. Shore lunch kits are available.

1. CATCH AND RELEASE WITH

Barbless Hooks but it takes more to preserve trophy fishing.

2. LIMIT FISHING PRESSURE

- Limit number of guests at each camp. (Capacity of our ten camps exceeds 100, we limit to 50 guests.)

- Limit camp openings (Alternate camps each year) We fish five lakes from our main lodge not counting fly out lakes.

- Limit time camps are open (Mid June-close before the end of July)

- Limit the need for fishing the deep holes. We normally close before the fish go deep.

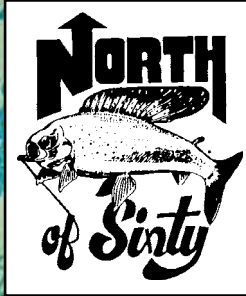
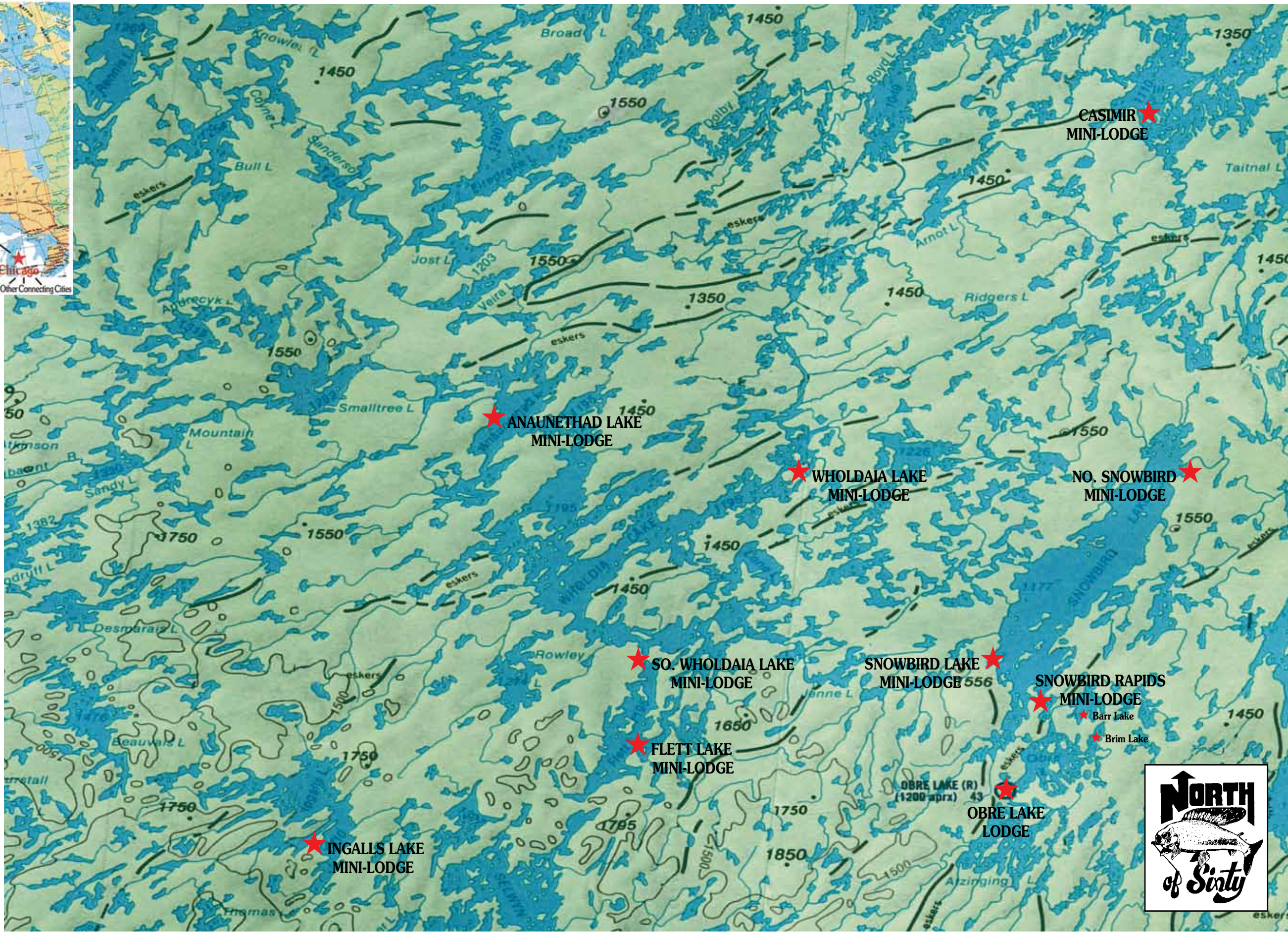
3. DISCOURAGE FISH OUT OF THE WATER OR CRADLE

Trophy fish bone's structure will not support their body weight out of the water. The fish are always bigger when you leave your camera at home.
